  - o Buildings Redwood 400 408 and Redwood 410-416 will be performed in June of 2020.
  - The board received bids from Bella: Redwood 409- 419 (odd number houses), Redwood 418 424 (even number houses) and Wildflower 300 306 (even number houses). Due to the increase the board will solicit other bids. We have received contact information from providers who Phase I use.
- Bug & Stinging Insect and Tick Spray
  - The Board have reached out to Bug-B-Gone for a quote for Insect and Tick Spraying. Looking to perform the work in May.
  - Due to the increase in deer presence, some residents have reported seeing ticks on their animals. With this weather it does not make sense to spray. We will as soon as the weather presents itself.

#### Roof Assessment

o For those residents who have chosen the \$100 monthly roof assessment plan, please keep in mind these payments have started (as of August, 2019) and you can include with your monthly association dues.

Also, those who have selected Quarterly, the second payment is due Feb 1 – for those that chose biannually the first payment is due Feb 1.

• The board has set up a separate account for this and will look to transfer the money for the roofs into this account.
